Your Entitlement to Drive

Before your first driving lesson I require to check your photo card Driving Licence.

This is for Insurance purposes, to see what vehicles you are allowed to drive and to check for any endorsements / penalty points / disqualifications. This is to protect you, me & the general public.

You will need to generate a "Code" to give to me ahead of your first lesson – to allow me to check your Driving Licence details – and you do this by following the steps below:

You will need:

Your Driving Licence

Your National Insurance Number

Your home Post Code

Then go to DVSA website: <https://www.gov.uk/view-driving-licence>

Step 1 – where you enter your Driving Licence Number, National Insurance Number and the Post Code as shown on your Driving Licence.

Step 2 – click on "Share Licence Information" and this will create a "Code". This "Code" is case-sensitive, can only be used once and is only valid for 21 days.

Step 3 – give this "Code" to me together with the last eight digits of your Driving Licence number.

Although I will use this information to view your Licence details online in advance of your first driving lesson, I will still require you to produce your photo card Driving Licence (for ID inspection on your first lesson) before the lesson can commence.
